Salaries

Salary expectations in renewables continue to rise, especially for those with expertise in hydrogen, Aldriven grid management, and offshore wind. Junior salaries are increasing thanks to demand, while senior professionals command premiums for specialised skills.

Employers are particularly seeking BESS and grid integration specialists to strengthen energy storage solutions; Al and data analytics professionals who can optimise smart energy production; and policy and regulatory experts to navigate evolving energy laws and compliance requirements. Demand for commissioning and construction professionals remains high due to the sector's rapid expansion and continued investment in renewables infrastructure.

Regional salary variations persist, with the **UK**, **Germany, Switzerland, and the Nordics** offering the highest salaries, while Southern Europe (Spain, Italy, Greece, and Portugal) has seen a 25% average increase in base salaries to compete with global employers offering remote work.

Contract-based roles are becoming more prevalent as companies seek flexibility, and specialist expertise, without long-term headcount commitments, particularly in project commissioning and construction.


